





# FREQUENTLY ASKED

# QUESTIONS

#### I am currently in my final year at university. Am I eligible to apply for FSTEP?

Yes, you may apply for FSTEP as long as you have obtained your final academic results and completed your internship by the time FSTEP commences.

### Is FSTEP, a full-time or part-time training programme?

FSTEP is a full-time training programme. During the 3-month classroom training, sessions start from 8.30am to 4.30pm on weekdays.

#### How much do I need to pay to join FSTEP?

FSTEP does not charge any fees. In fact, upon joining FSTEP, trainees will be paid a minimum monthly allowance of RM2,600 (for 3+9-month) by the respective participating financial institutions.

#### Will I be offered a permanent position after FSTEP?

Generally, FSTEP trainees will be offered a permanent role (based on their performance) after the 9-month on-the-job training with their respective participating financial institutions.

#### Does FSTEP accept graduates with non-finance qualifications (e.g., Psychology, Engineering and Computer Science)?

We accept graduates with finance and non-finance qualifications, provided they meet our admission requirements.

#### Do I have to sign a bond?

Generally, you will be bonded throughout the 3+9-month training programme. If you withdraw during the programme, you will need to reimburse a sum of money to your sponsoring financial institution as stated in the contract/ Letter of Offer.
